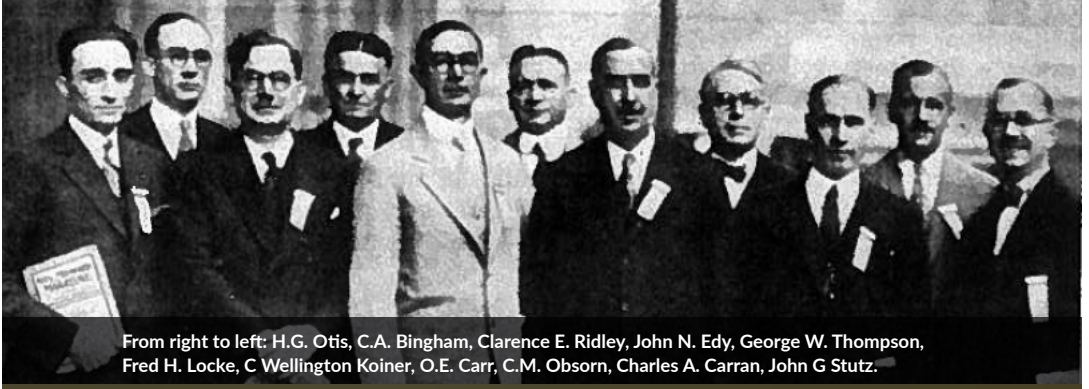

O.E. Carr, city manager of Dubuque, Iowa, addressed 100 of his colleagues gathered in Montreal in 1924 at the ICMA Annual Conference to present them with a code of ethics for the profession: "The City Manager's Code of Ethics." For 100 years, the ICMA Code of Ethics has been the foundation of the local government management profession, guiding leaders and setting the standard for excellence. Adopted in 1924, the principles outlined in the Code remain timeless. Today, we remain committed to the following, which all come from the first version of Code: integrity, public service, seeking no favor from a public position, exemplary conduct in both personal and professional matters, respecting the role and contributions of elected officials, exercising the independence to do what is right, political neutrality, serving the public equitably and governing body members equally, keeping the community informed about local government matters, and supporting and leading our employees.

ICMA members pledge to uphold the values in the Code in their professional and personal conduct as well as decisions to merit the trust of the public, elected officials, and staff they serve. Visit icma.org/ethics100.

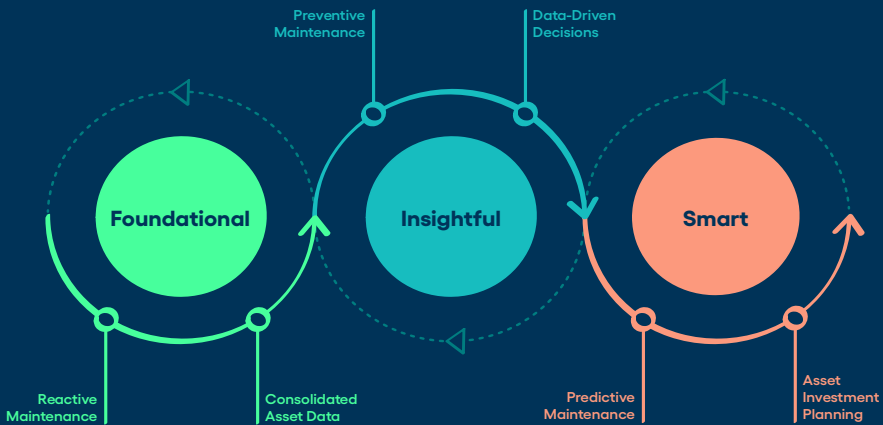

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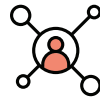

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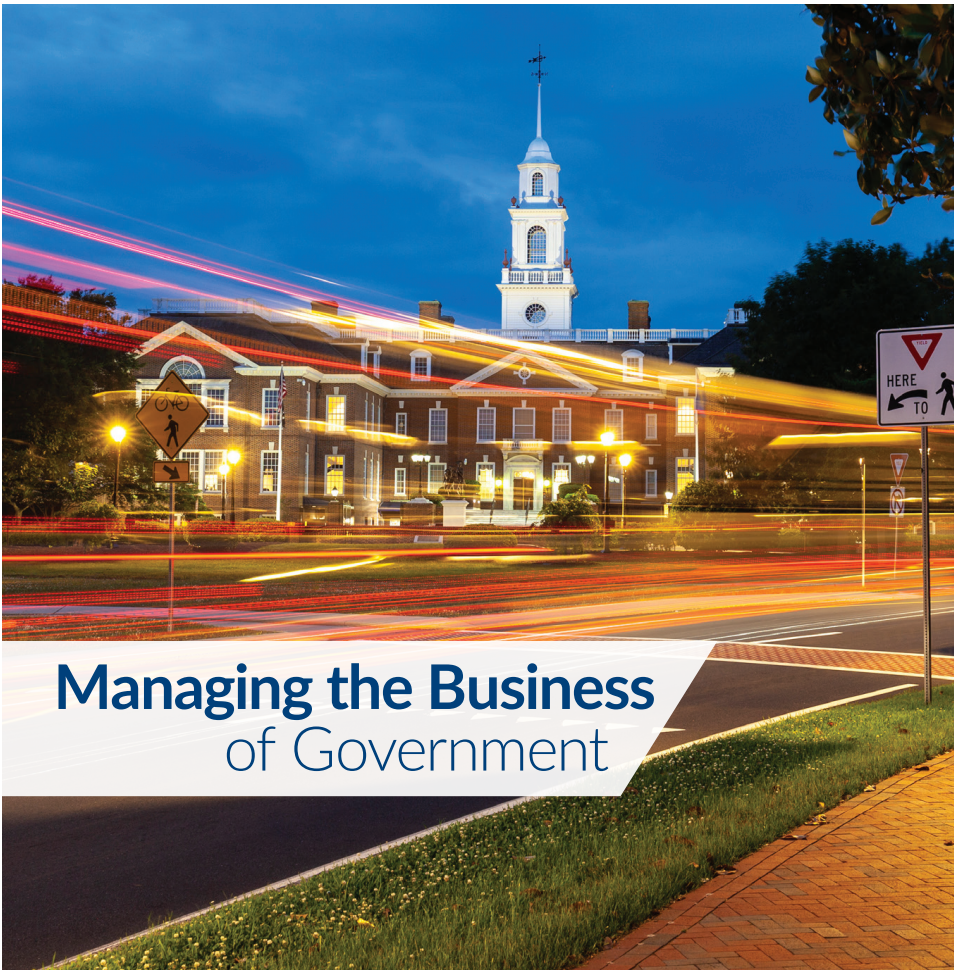
